



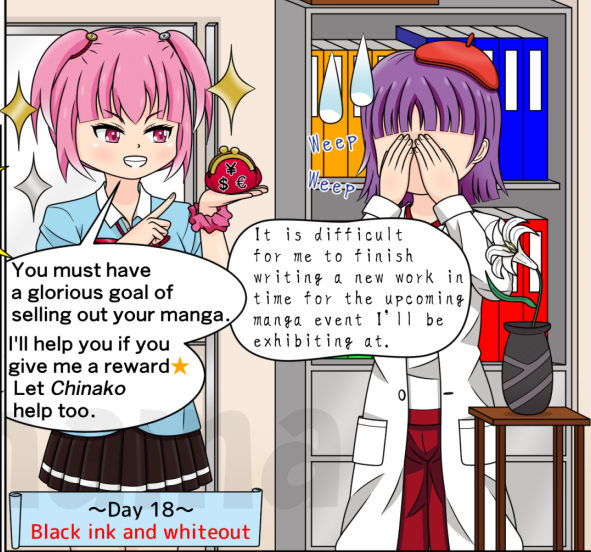
Stop it!

Black ink and whiteout

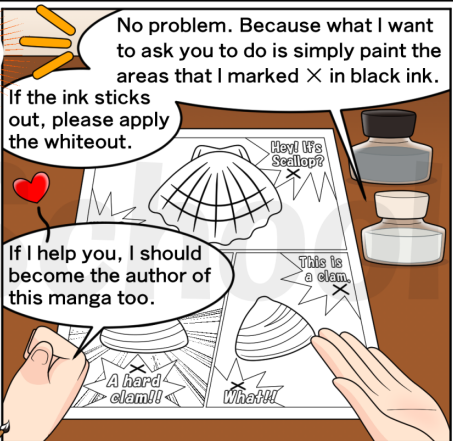


Unfortunately, you aren't the author of it.
