

Act more like a hostage!

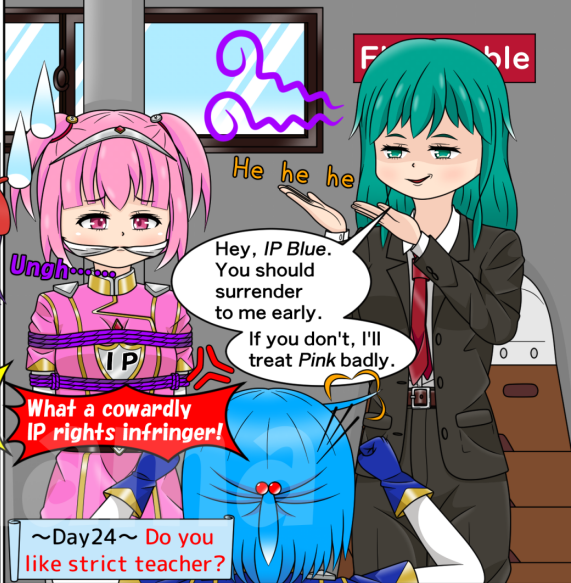
HMMPPP!

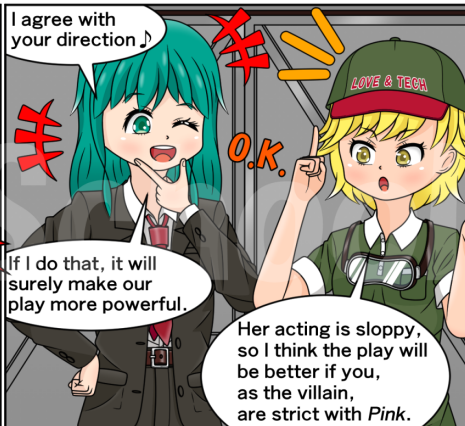


You are now also "a performer".

Performers don't mean just person like you who actually acting.

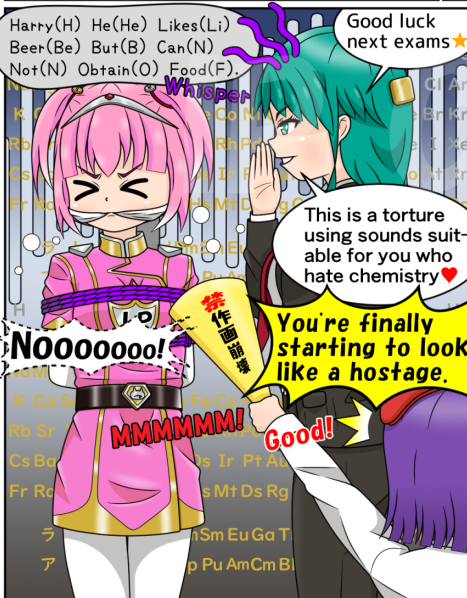
Congratulations!

Not(N) Obtain(O) Food(F).

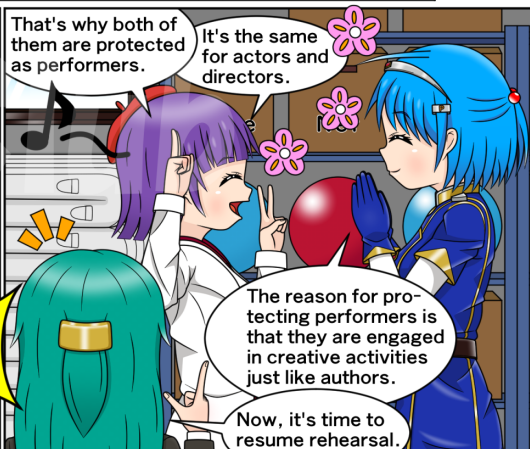
