Is it permissible to make a parody of someone else's speech and use it as a slogan?

No problem. Japanese Copyright Act stipulates that it is permissible to exploit in any way "**a political speech delivered in public**" (Article 40, Paragraph 1).

However, Lincoln's copyright expired long ago.



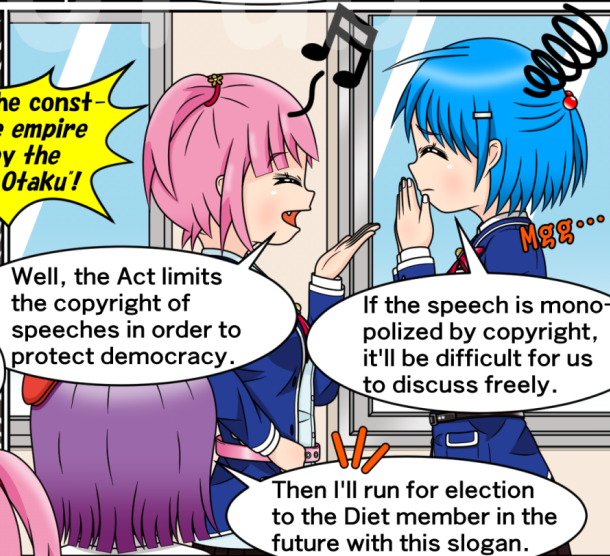
My slogan is the construction of the empire of the Otaku by the Otaku for the Otaku!
