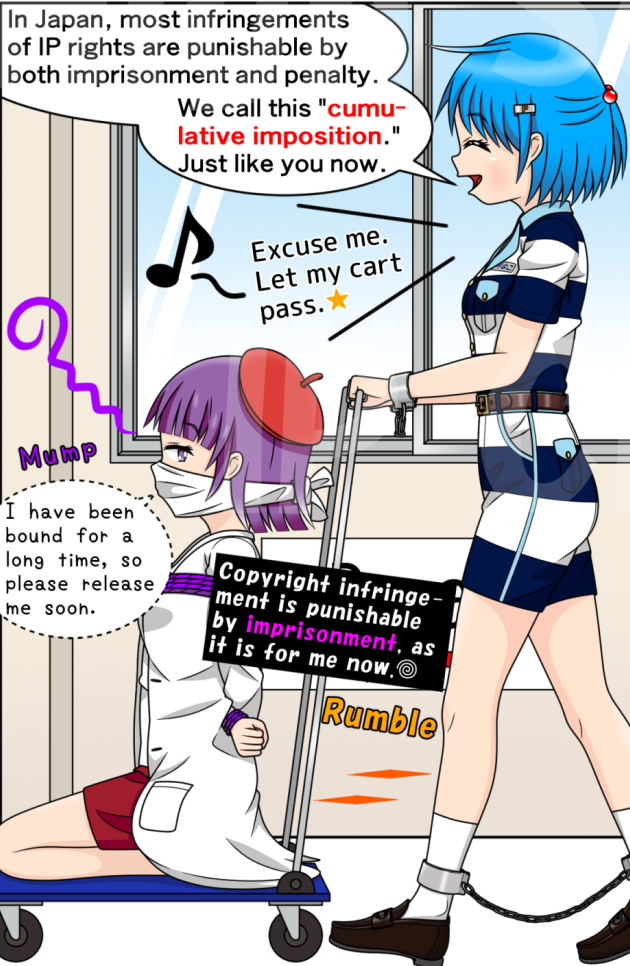
Well, the group selling pirated copies left as soon as they saw her.
