Misube-go. This is Chinako-maru. Over.

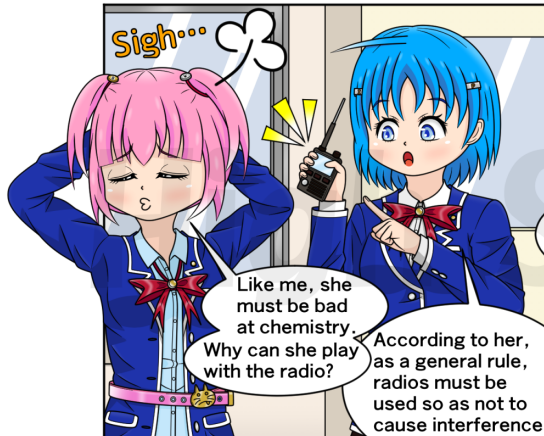


I've got a license as a "Maritime III-Category Special Radio Operator" too, so I'm all set★

I have "2nd class boat's operator license", so let's go cruising on next weekend.

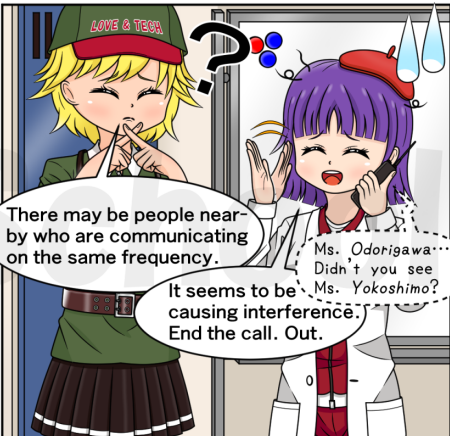

Ms. Odorigawa... Didn't you see Ms. Yokoshimo?



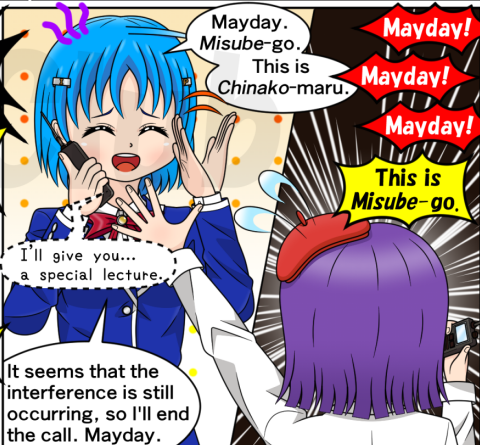
Your hoisting of NC flag (rescue call flag) is good
