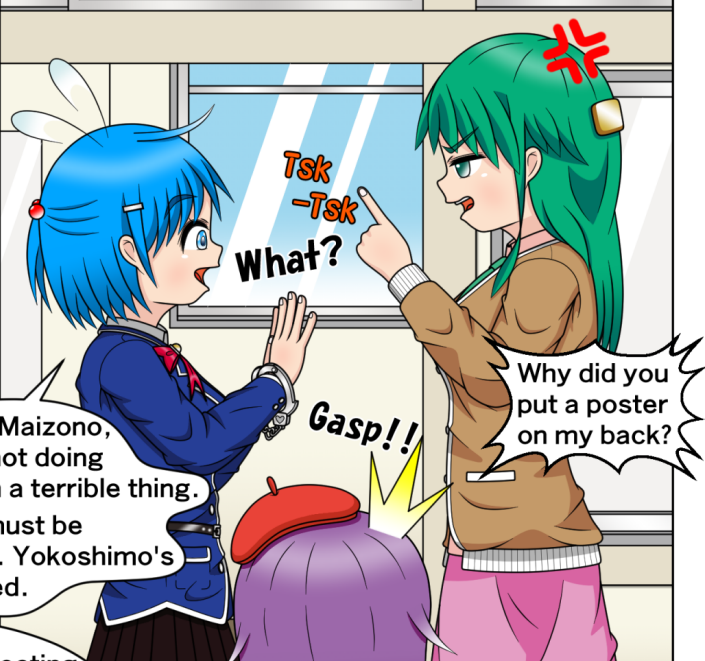
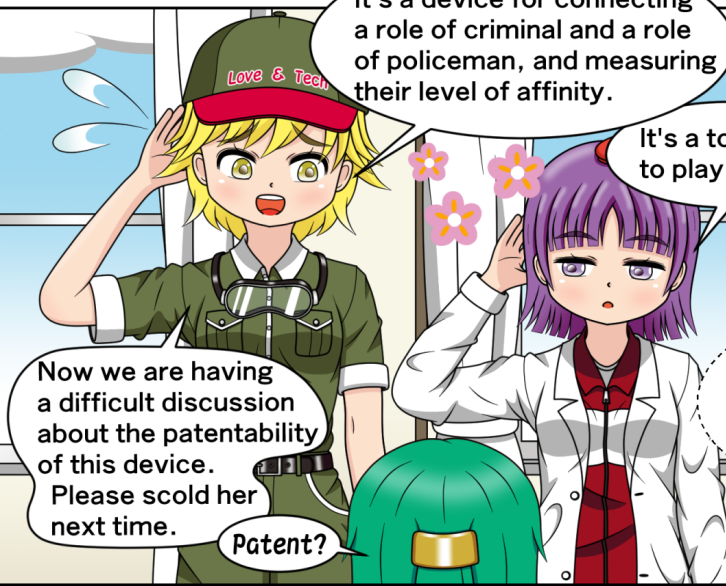

 Ms. Maizono, I'm not doing such a terrible thing. It must be Ms. Yokoshimo's deed.

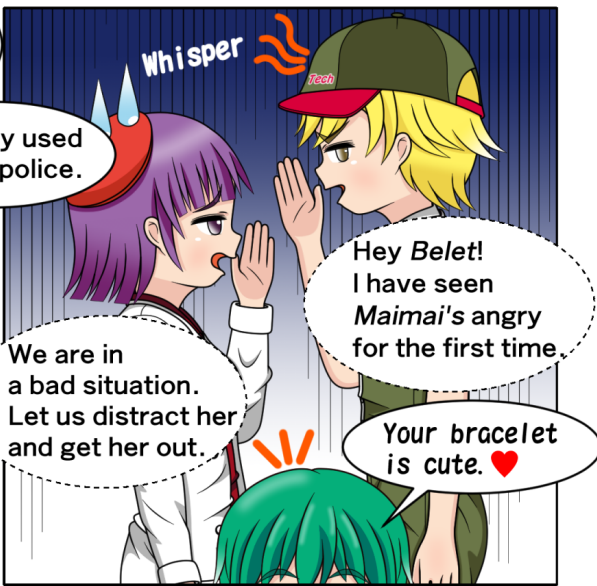
Why did you put a poster on my back?

 Patent?

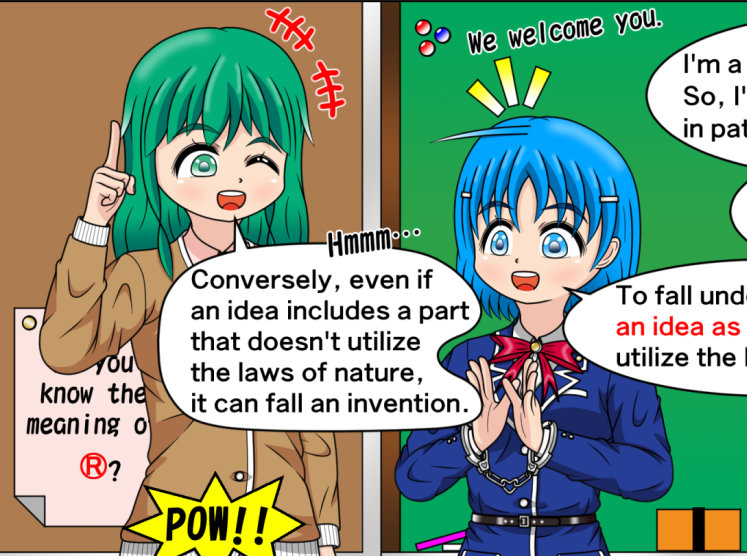


Whisper

Your bracelet is cute. ♥



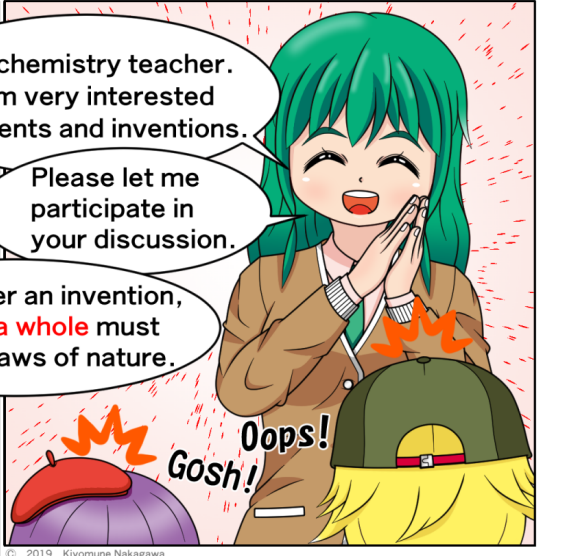

 I'm a chemistry teacher. So, I'm very interested in patents and inventions.

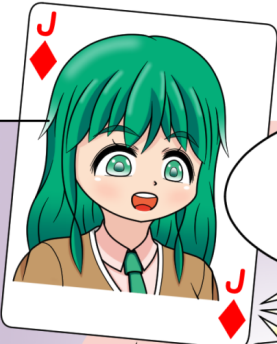
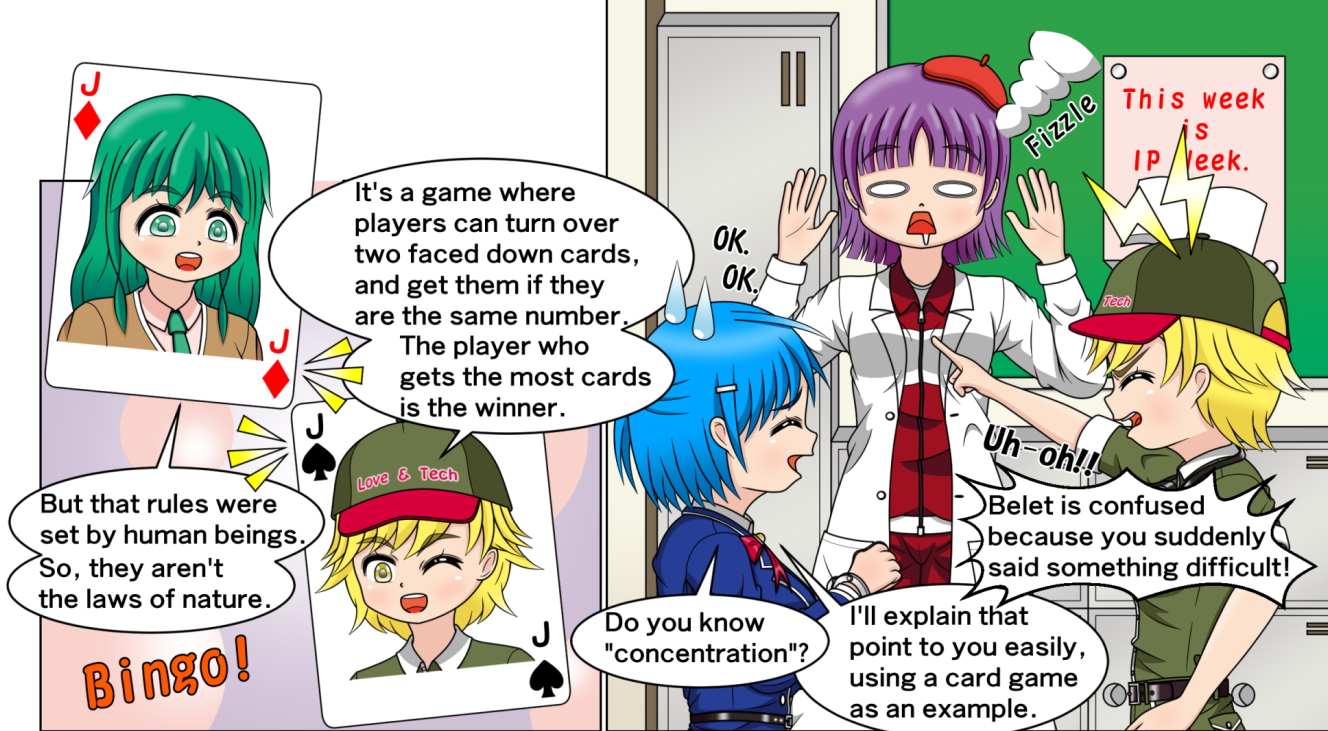

The purpose for flashing cards are to make it easier for the player to remember the position of the card. The rules of concentration aren't many related to the idea of this cards.

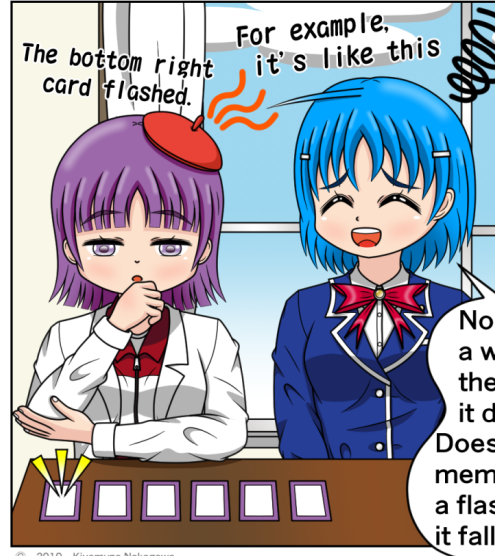
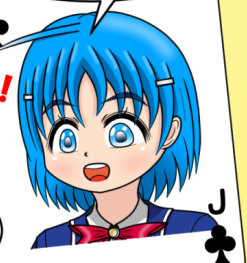


**Flash!**

The cards for practicing concentration utilize the laws of nature as a whole of idea. Then, if an idea includes a part that utilizes the laws of nature, does it fall always an invention?

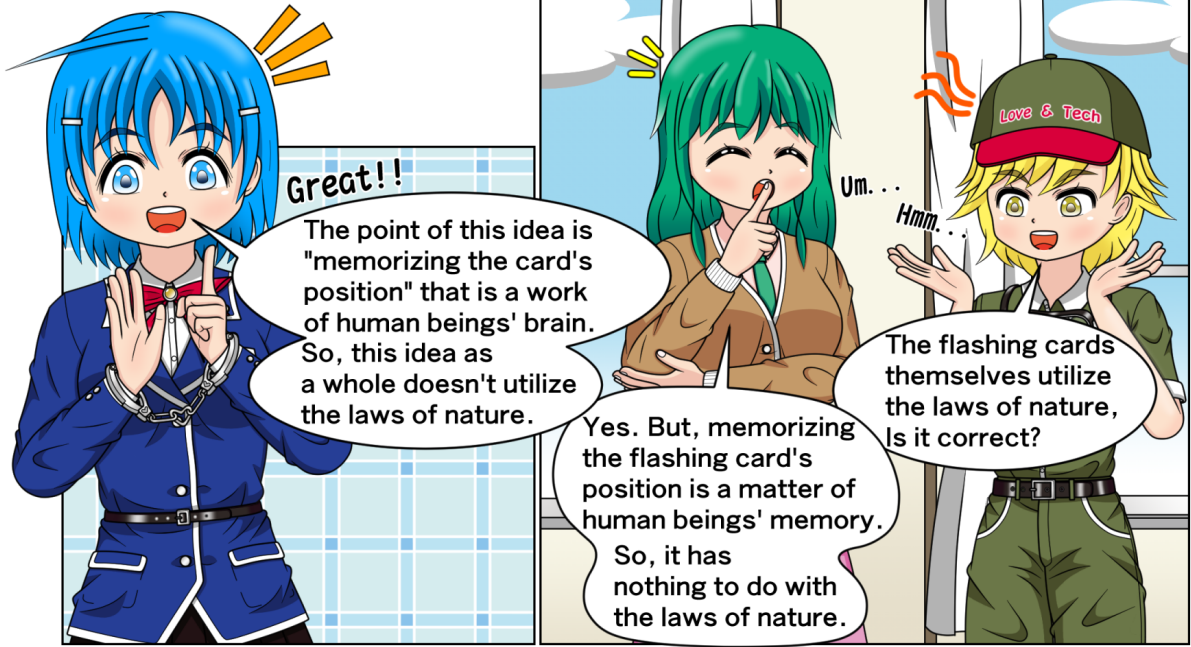

Yes. But, memorizing the flashing card's position is a matter of human beings' memory. So, it has nothing to do with the laws of nature.

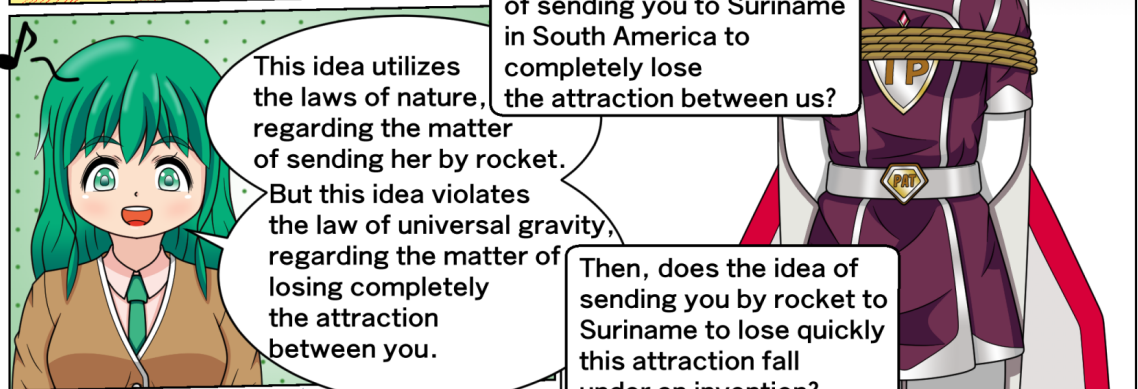


Yeah!

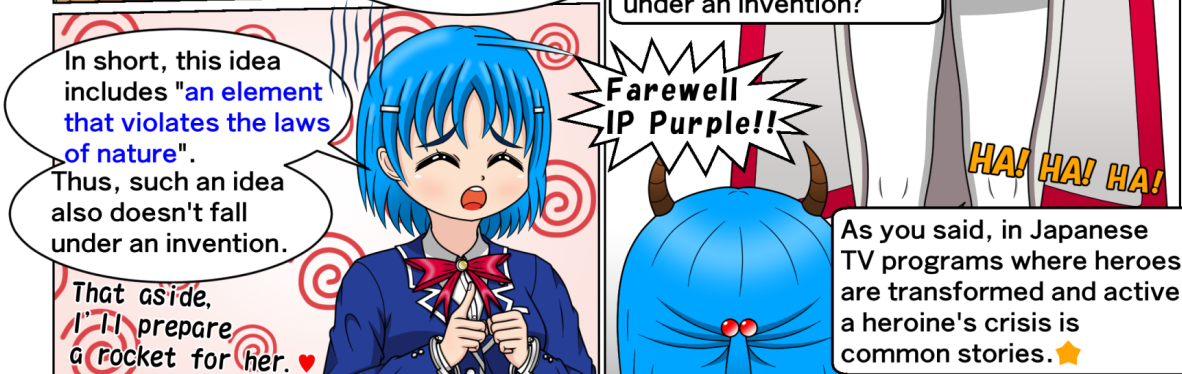
By the way...

In short, this idea includes "an element that violates the laws of nature". Thus, such an idea also doesn't fall under an invention.

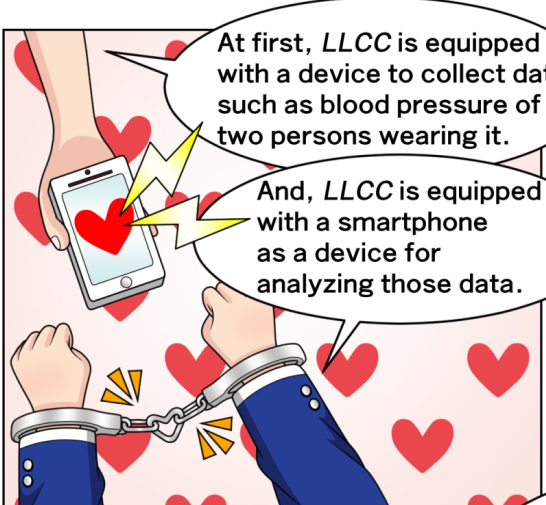

**Clasp!**

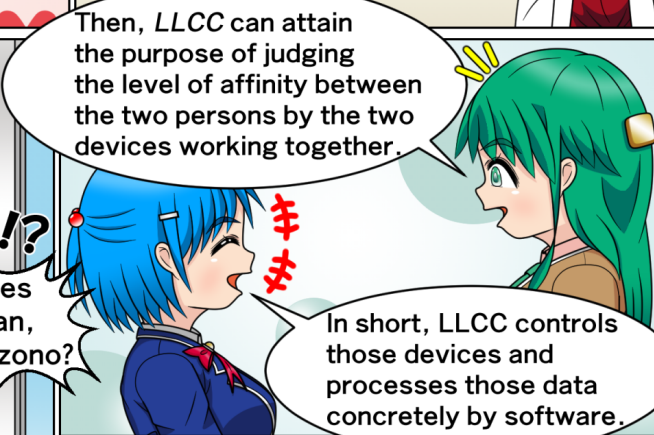
**Huh!?**

Maizono detective will examine you carefully in my room about the matter of the poster!

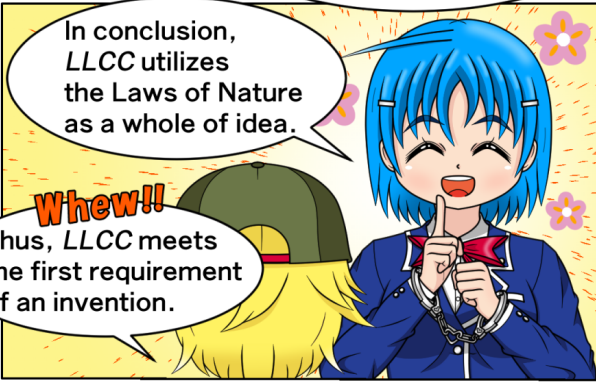

Then, LLCC can attain the purpose of judging the level of affinity between the two persons by the two devices working together.

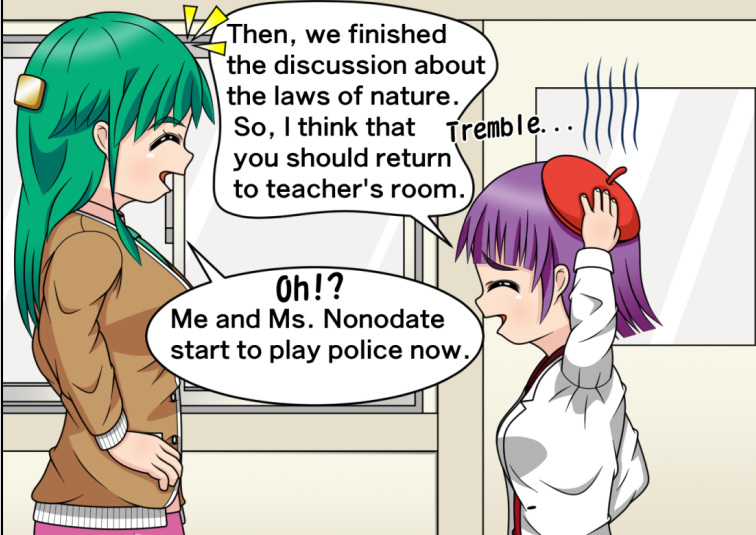
In short, LLCC controls those devices and processes those data concretely by software.
