
Art 4: Requirement

capability!




What! Hero?

In other words, it means that "individuality" is appearing in a work.


What is creativity?

whether the author is an adult or a child, their works fall under the copyrighted work, right?

As an example, consider the case where I copy the picture you drew.




But, if a product is made by human being,

And, like a formula, "conventional re-presentation" doesn't have creativity.


People prefer a heroine with a weak point than a perfect heroine.

Slither


$$l = 2 \pi r$$
